Spirit of Westwood Scholarship

Scholarships are available for Westwood High School Students graduating during the 2013-2014 school year. Students who will be attending community colleges, state colleges, or trade and vocational schools in the fall of 2014 are eligible.

To apply, include all of the following:

- SELF-DESCRIPTION: In your own words, describe personal characteristics and accomplishments that would help a committee form an opinion of you as a person. Include personal and academic goals, interests and hobbies, contributions to school and community, and any significant events and experiences that have influenced your life. Tell about future goals. This description **should not be** more than two pages long and **should be** double spaced.
- REFERENCE LETTERS: Three (3) reference letters must be attached to the application.
- CURRENT TRANSCRIPTS
- **Applications are due in the Westwood counseling office by February 20, 2014 at 4:00 PM.**

The Craig and Susan Thomas Foundation Scholarship

Scholarships are available to Wyoming residents who will attend Wyoming community colleges, trade and vocational schools or the University. To qualify for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- High School diploma, GED or eligible for school program for which you are applying.
- Wyoming and US citizen.
- NOT receiving the Hathaway Scholarship.

Preference for this scholarship is given to At-Risk Youth, Learning Disabled, Environmentally Disadvantaged or Developmentally Disabled. Applications may be obtained from the website: www.Thomas-Foundation.com

Applications for this scholarship are due May 1st of the current year for classes beginning in the fall semester.

The Wyoming Trucking Association Scholarship Fund

The Wyoming Trucking Association Scholarship Fund will be awarding its Transportation Education Scholarships for the 2014-2015 school year. Amounts will range from \$500 to \$1,500.

Scholarships will be awarded to a Wyoming high school graduate who is enrolled in a Wyoming college, the University or trade school for the 2014-2015 school year. Students must be enrolled in courses which could lead to a career in the transportation industry in Wyoming. These courses include, but are not limited to: Business management, accounting, diesel mechanics, truck driving training, office procedures & management, computer skills and safety. The scholarship program includes scholarships from the WTA Trust Fund, the Cohee Family Scholarship, the L.E. Meredith Memorial Scholarship, the Larry Chapman Memorial Scholarship and the WTA Council of Safety and Supervisors Scholarship.
